
This spacious, designer-furnished apartment with high ceilings is located on the 2nd floor of a beautifully renovated historic building with a modern elevator. This elegant Neo-Renaissance residence stands in the very heart of the city, just steps from Wenceslas Square and Vrchlického Sady Park, which is being extensively revitalized.

The apartment’s layout consists of a living room with a kitchen and dining area, 2 bedrooms (one with a built-in sleeping loft), a bathroom (with a walk-in shower and toilet), a separate guest toilet, and an entrance hall. The apartment is accessed via a **gallery walkway** (7 m²), which is exclusively used by this and the neighboring apartment.

The timeless interior was designed by an **architectural studio**. High-quality features include **wooden floors**, soundproof windows, central heating, and a **heat recovery ventilation system**. The kitchen is fully equipped, and the purchase price includes all interior furnishings. The entire building was successfully renovated in 2019 under the direction of the **renowned OOOOX studio**. It is equipped with an **elevator** and a **camera system**; the apartment comes with a **cellar**.

The neighborhood is full of restaurants and shops, with theaters, cinemas, **the State Opera**, and the **National Museum** all within walking distance. All metro lines and tram stops are easily accessible, and after the **revitalization of the park by the Main Railway Station**, a new tram stop will be just a few steps from the building.
