

This family villa designed by the architects of the Czech Pavilion at the ongoing Expo 2025 in Osaka is surrounded by a garden with mature trees, located in a peaceful and green part of a newly built residential neighborhood in the Prague district of Slivenec, right next to Chuchelský Grove.

The ground floor is dominated by an open plan living space with a kitchen and hidden pantry, further comprising a study, a bathroom, a hallway, and a walk-in wardrobe. The living area is connected to two terraces. The upper floor is functionally divided into a parent's and a children's zone. The parent's zone consists of a bedroom, a study/walk-in wardrobe, and a bathroom, while two additional bedrooms and a bathroom are reserved for children. The entire house is crowned by a rooftop terrace with a symbolic captain's deck, offering postcard-worthy views of Prague.

The villa, with architecture referencing the Functionalist era, was approved for occupancy in 2020. The perfect composition of the house, the use of natural elements, originality, and attention to detail lend the home a unique charm. Attention has been paid to every detail. The exterior stands out for its metallic plaster combined with wooden cladding, rain chains from the gutters, and a green roof with a cooling function. The interior is enriched with exposed concrete with a wood texture that complements the oak floors; the staircase is also made of oak. The entire house features underfloor heating, and a fireplace adds to the cozy winter atmosphere. The windows can be shaded using blinds with a cooling function. All storage spaces were custom-made by a carpenter and open by touch. The professionally designed and maintained garden is equipped with an automatic irrigation system. Parking for two cars with a charging station is available on the plot.


The location on a cul-de-sac ensures **peace** and **privacy**, with the **Radotínsko-Chuchelský Forest Park** beginning just a few steps from the garden. The historic center of the district, with a grocery store, kindergarten and elementary school, and several restaurants, is within a 15-minute walk. Full civic amenities are easily accessible, and the Prague Ring Road can be reached very quickly by car.

Total area 186.92 m², of which interior floor area 156.15 m² and terraces 19.62 m^2 , 7.35 m^2 and 3.8 m^2 , built-up area 106 m^2 , garden 648 m^2 , plot 754 m^2 .



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
